We will be highlighting the letters Nn, Oo, and Ff, but do focus on the whole alphabet in many of our activities. We continue to have many opportunities to strengthen our fine motor skills by cutting, pasting, tracing, and coloring. We are also working to improve our large motor skills with activities in the classroom, and outside. Next week we will take a class walk in the neighborhood to make observations about Autumn, as well as collect leaves from different trees. We will talk about colors, and our 5 senses. In addition to Thanksgiving, we will learn about Veterans Day and Voting Day.
