

## SNOW CLOSING PROCEDURES

The Beechwood School will be open as much as possible during the winter weather. School hours are determined by the amount of snow, road conditions, police recommendations and surrounding school districts decisions. If you are not sure if we are open, please check our website or call 429-0303. Thank you.

Below are some guidelines:

1. The Beechwood School will be closed completely due to six (6) inches of snow and/or hazardous road conditions.
2. If there are less than six inches (6") of snow and the surrounding public schools are closed due to road conditions or the timing of the storm, the Beechwood School may also be closed. If we are able to open, the Beechwood School will most likely not open until about 8am and regular classes will not be held. Please check our website or call for opening time.
3. Early closing: The Beechwood School will try to stay open throughout the day. However, if there are more than six inches of snow predicted during the day, **or** if there are icy road conditions, we will close early. If your child is attending school that day, you will be contacted.
4. During the snowy and icy weather, road conditions may necessitate that you leave work early to allow extra time for driving.

The Beechwood School is sensitive to the needs of our working parents and does its best to remain open as much as reasonably possible during the winter season. However, the safety of our students, families and staff is our #1 priority. Using the information we have available to us from local authorities, school districts and weather prognosticators, we make our decisions as timely as possible with safety in mind. After two weather closings Beechwood School will make up any additional closed days.
