September is now over and the children are adjusting well to our classroom rules and routines. We are enjoying getting to know your children. Thank you for attending Back to School Night!

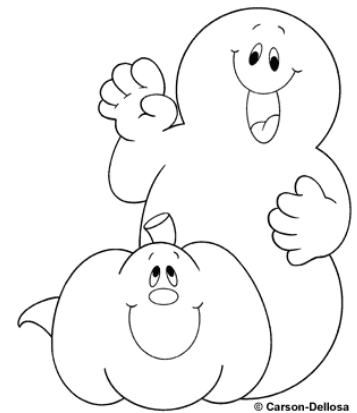
We ended September by celebrating Johnny Appleseed's birthday and learning about his life.
