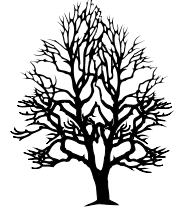


November Newsletter

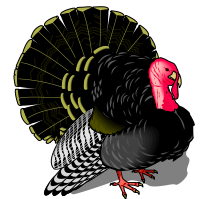


October was Fire Prevention Month. We learned how to Stop – Drop and Fall and enjoyed our visit with the Firefighters.
