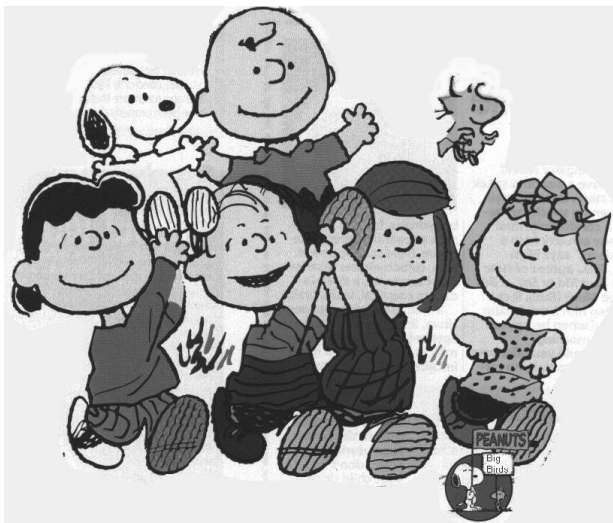
Dear Parents,
