Brrr! It's cold outside! But inside our classroom it's nice and warm and cozy as the busy children play and sing and bake the days away.

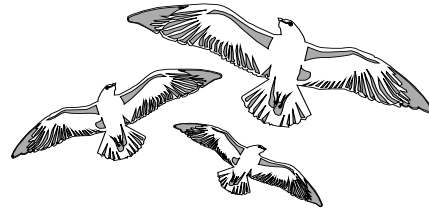
In January we all stayed awake while learning about hibernation and we all longingly wished we could migrate with the birds to a warmer climate. The Children
